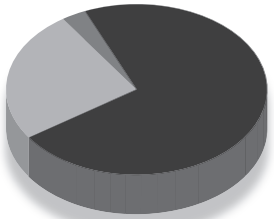

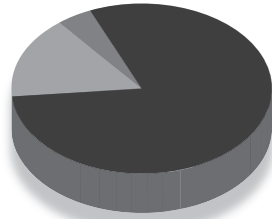

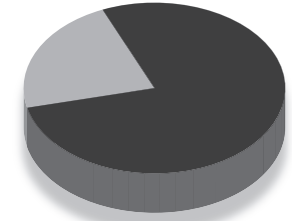

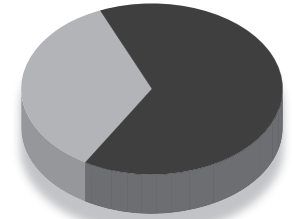
Should high speed 2 rail project be scrapped?
