9.a Cabin.

10 PLANNING SUB-COMMITTEE REPORT

P/1 Wright's roof

Retrospective planning permission is being sought for the roofing material, ref. 15/05100/4.

Decision will be on 13th March 2015, so objections must be lodged by then. Letters of objection to be sent to Wycombe District Council from Rosemary (for HVRA) and Angus & Janet (for Whitfield Road residents).

RH reports that several footpaths have been cleared of overgrowth by TfB (Orchard Close to the school, and from Cryers Hill roundabout to the entrance to Hughenden Park).

- DH reported that 2 trees on the N side of Cryers Hill Road had fallen across the footpath & carriageway. DH reported to TfB who dealt with the problem.

An additional tree appears to be at risk & a survey would be a sensible precaution. To request from TfB.

f(ii) Police camera signs

Police camera sign is in place on Warrendene Road, the broken one on the village gate by the surgery will be replaced, & a new one placed at the top of Coombe Lane.

f(iii) Community Speed Watch (CSW)

In 2014 2380 letters were sent out to speeding drivers by Thames Valley Police. The 57 volunteers of the Community Speed Watch group are the most active in Bucks. RH asked for volunteers for Speed Watch for an hour on 4th February but no one was available.

f(iv)Mobile Vehicle Activated Speed Device (MVAS)

This should now be on a post outside Deeters.

f(v) Hughenden Parish Council (HPC) has put in a bid to the Local Area Forum (LAF) for funding to change the speed limits on Cryers Hill Lane & Pipers Lane to 30 mph for the complete length of the roads. RH asked NAG if Coombe Lane could be added to the bid list because PC Lee Turnham agrees that the 40 mph should be reduced to 30, & would support us with the request. After some discussion the Committee agreed to ask James Perkins to take the request forward to HPC & the LAF.
