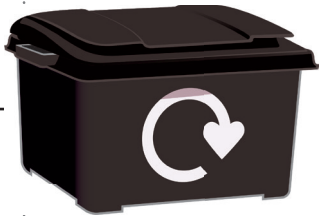

You can recycle paper and cardboard, as long as it's not waxed or soiled with food or oil.

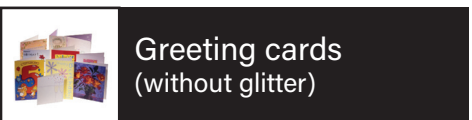
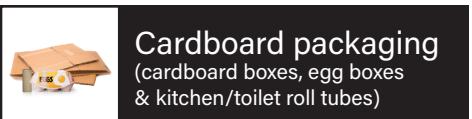
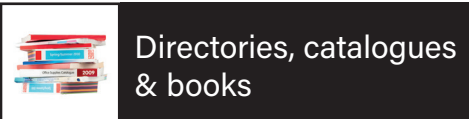
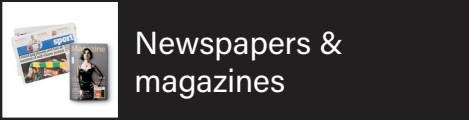
