	Drainage improvement works have now been carried out along Valley Road/Coombe	
	Lane to include extra drainage, a new road surface and raising of the kerbs.	
	The issue of riparian rights along Broomhedge has still not been resolved. The most	
	recent response from Sarah Ashmead at BCC suggests that there is no evidence as	
	to where responsibility lies for the section of the stream that runs down Boss Lane, so	
	for now her last correspondence of 11 May 2020 has been left as documentation on	
	the HVDIG website.	
	As Karen Fisher (Strategic Flood Management Team Leader) has now moved on,	
	nothing has been heard back from Darren Trenchard (Thames Water) regarding the	
	deployment of overpumping/treatment units in the event of a flooding situation like the	
	one we had in 2014 and there is now a new MP (Rob Butler) for the area, DW feels he	
	has taken his role as Chairman as far as it can go and decided to step down.
