### WORKS INFORMATION AND NOTIFICATION LETTER: Manor Road, Hughenden Valley

We are writing to inform you that Buckinghamshire Highways will be carrying out Conventional Surfacing Capital Maintenance work along Manor Road, Hughenden Valley from Valley Road to the end of the road (although the works may extend beyond these points).

The works are programmed to take place from Friday 13<sup>th</sup> September 2024, and it is anticipated the Conventional Surfacing Capital Maintenance work will take approximately 3 days to complete. The work will be carried out using a road closure, in operation Friday to Tuesday between 07:00 -19:00.

Information signs and parking suspension signs will be erected on site before work begins, giving actual dates and durations. You will appreciate that works of this nature are extremely weather dependant and therefore may be subject to disruption due to adverse weather. If the works are delayed, the advance information signs on site will be updated to reflect any changes.

Every effort will be made to maintain access for residents within the confines of the closure, although there may be times when it is not safe to do so, and we apologise for any inconvenience. **It is vital that vehicles are not parked on the road and/or footway as this will prevent the works from being completed.**

In the interests of health, safety and welfare, we **cannot guarantee** vehicular access within the confines of the working area. Vehicles travelling along Manor Road during site working hours may be subject to **lengthy delays**. Any access arrangements for those who reside within the closure area will be **at the discretion** of our traffic management operatives. Please refer to the advanced warning notices erected on site prior to the works beginning, for work dates and durations. We apologise for any inconvenience caused.
